Sparkling & Champagne

1. **Louis Perdrier 'Brut Excellence', Burgundy**
Delicate and elegant, this burgundian sparkling wine is fresh, crisp and very appealing.
Bottle: £16.50
2. **Pannier 'Brut Selection', Champagne**
It took at least 3 years in the cellar to get these bubbles to flirt with you. Pannier is a house that refuses to follow the masses, concentrating instead completely on quality.

White Wines

3. **Ca' di Ponti Catarratto, Sicily**
A lively and refreshing Sicilian white full of floral and white fruit flavours. Elegant yet with enough body to marry well with a wealth of food style

4. **Broken Shackle Semillon Chardonnay, Australia**
A tantalising blend of lemon and lime notes from the Semillon with ripe, more tropical notes from the Chardonnay.

5. **GPG Pinot Grigio Garganega, Veneto, Italy**
A clever piece of blending, marrying the spice and freshness of Pinot Grigio with the more creamy, hazlenut notes of Garganega.

6. **Kintu Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile**
Cooled by the Pacific this Sauvignon Blanc is fragrant with elderflower notes on the nose giving way to a more tropical scented palate.

7. **Ayama Chenin Blanc, Paarl, South Africa**
A rich and flavoursome Chenin with enough body to work well with many food styles, honeysuckle and green apple notes.

8. **Chardonnay 'Le Bel Ange', Dom Begude, South France**
An un-oaked Chardonnay, soft, clean and very elegant. A beautiful winery successfully managed by a British family.

9. **Knappstein 'Handpicked' Riesling, Australia**
Bone-dry Riesling. The tight minerality of this wine and intensity of flavour make it an excellent partner to rich and spicy dishes.

10. **Te Tera Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ**
On the gravel soils of Marlborough this Sauvignon Blanc crafted expertly, with gooseberry and green fruit aromas that make this characterful style of wine so popular.

11. **Chablis, Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard, Burgundy**
Brocard produce a fine and very mineral style of Chablis. The green tight style of this wine, gives it incredible poise and length.

Rosé Wines

12. **Borsao Rosado, Campo de Borja, Spain**
Raspberry and cranberry aromas and flavours with enough tannin to give the wine bite.
Bottle: £14.50 Per 175ml Glass: £3.95

Red Wines

13. **Il Banchetto Sangiovese, Italy**
Grown on the beautiful hills of Emilia Romagna, this sun-soaked wine, full of dark berry fruit has a lovely spicy overtone and is full of character.

14. **Tierra Alta Merlot, Rapel Valley, Chile**
The sunshine is tempered by the cool breeze off the Andes results in a vibrant, fruit driven wine full of cassis flavours.

15. **Borsao Garnacha, Campo de Borja, Spain**
An incredibly popular red, packed with berry fruit and with enough depth and interest to suggest a much more expensive wine

16. **Paddock Cabernet Shiraz, South Australia**
Black forest fruit flavours and spicy notes is what you should expect from a great Aussie Shiraz, and this wine has them all in abundance.

17. **Domaine de Montmarin Merlot, South France**
Soft and approachable exactly as Merlot should be, but not too jammy. It has the freshness and elegance of good quality Bordeaux.

18. **KC Shiraz, Klein Constantia, South Africa**
These vines on the wonderful slopes of Constantia have views to be envious of and ripen grapes to perfection. This rich Shiraz has taken on the oak aromas to give the wine a tobacco and spice character.

19. **Rioja, Bodegas Navajas, Spain**
An impressive, structured Rioja with enough juicy red berry fruit to make the wine very approachable and balanced.

20. **Chateau de Roques, Premieres Cotes de Bordeaux**
This is 100% Merlot and shows cassis notes on the nose, with tobacco and spice overtones. The elegant palate is constrained by gripping tannins and fresh acidity.

21. **Fleurie 'La Roilette', Domaine Metrat, Beaujolais**
This Gamay, grown on the deep granite soils of the 'La Roilette', is as pure and as silky an expression of the Gamay grape that you will find.

22. **Domaine du Noble, Loupiac, Bordeaux**
An outstanding dessert wine, produced from botrytis infected grapes. Honey and floral notes on the nose, rich fruit and crisp acidity.
